Lin is a Vietnam Navy Veteran who served as a machinist mate. He had been unable to see a dentist for several years due to financial constraints.

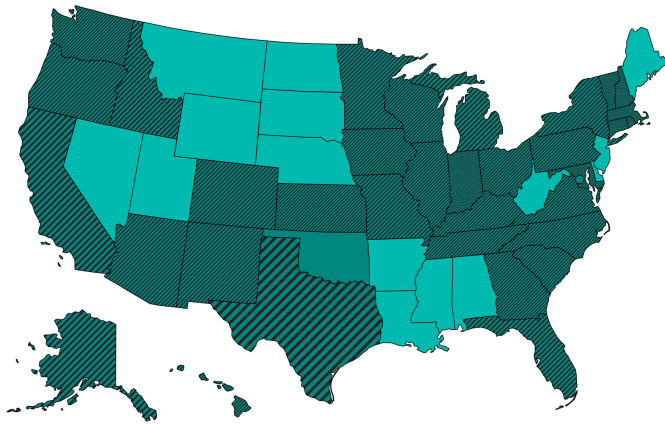
When he came to our program he was living with multiple loose teeth, constant pain, and infection that impacted all aspects of his life. We were able to assign him to Dr. Michael Yeh, a prosthodontist from Federal Way, WA. Dr. Yeh's compassionate comprehensive approach has made a tremendous impact on Lin's life. He extracted several teeth, provided bone grafts, and 10 dental implants with crowns.




Lin shared that his dental journey with Dr. Yeh and his team was amazing and has made a huge difference. He said, "I'm more comfortable all the way around and the infections in my mouth are gone". He went on to say, "I can't thank E4V enough for connecting me with Dr. Yeh and his team. Everyone involved was wonderful".

We are so grateful to be a part of Lin's story. Chronic pain and infection kept Lin from the hobbies that he enjoyed and the activities that positively impacted his physical and mental well-being. Now that he is pain-free he can get back to his favorite pastime of playing golf. Lin, may your swing be straight, your ball fly far, & all your rounds be no more than par!

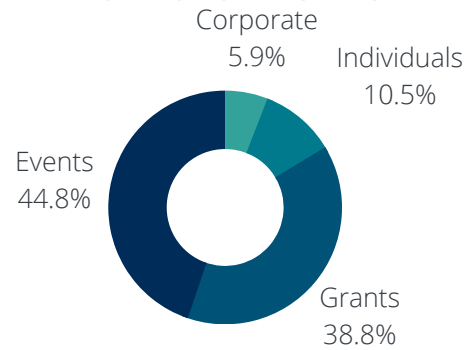

National Impact



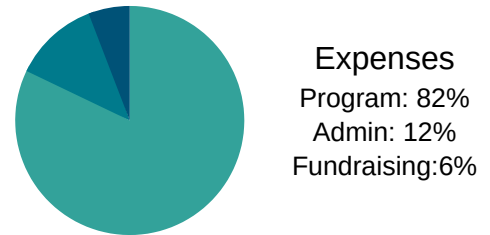

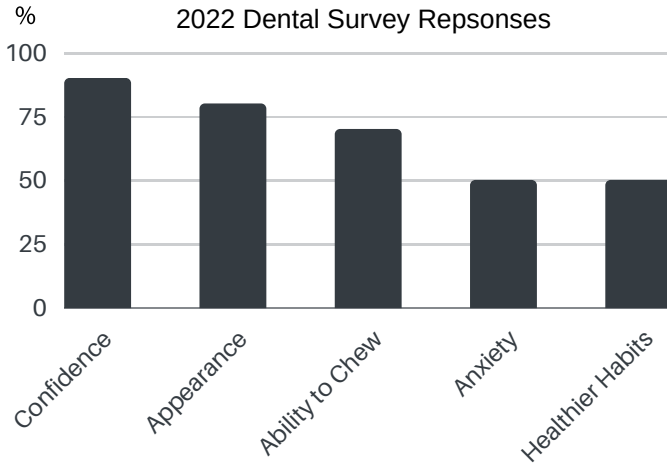

Top 5 Quality of Life Improvements

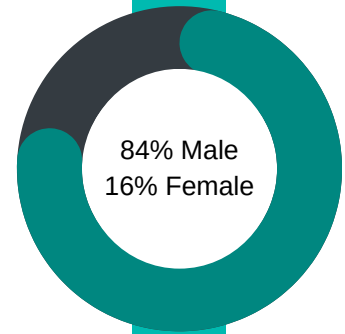
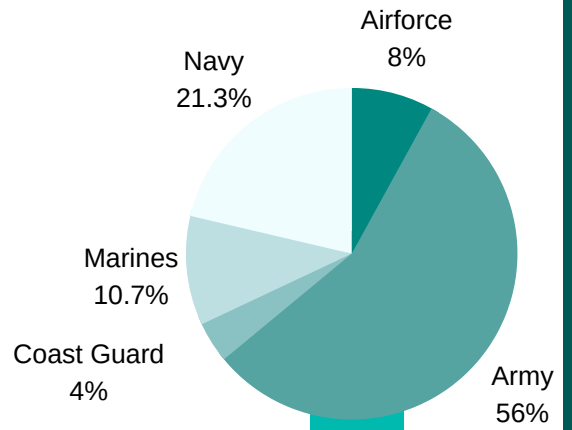


Veterans and their spouses are invited to complete an anonymous survey following their comprehensive dental treatment. The quotes below are responses from our **2022 Program Survey**.

- We celebrated our **5 year anniversary** and an important milestone of providing more than **\$1 million** in donated dental care.
- E4V was a recipient of the **2022 Fisher Service Award for Military Community Service**. E4V was recognized for its uniqueness and innovative programming from a field of over 600 nonprofits.
- We increased in-kind services for veterans and their families by **58%** from 2021.
- Our Founder and Board President, Dr. Theresa Cheng was honored by the American Academy of Periodontology with the **H. Dalton Connor Humanitarian Award** for her service to veterans through E4V.
- **Seer Interactive** partnered with us to overhaul our SEO and analytics. This has made a tremendous improvement in organic traffic to our website. The noticeable increase in our Google page ranking is bringing more awareness to our programs.
- Our Board of Directors unanimously voted to expand our eligibility requirements to include **all qualified veterans experiencing financial hardship**, no longer limiting services to combat veterans exclusively.
